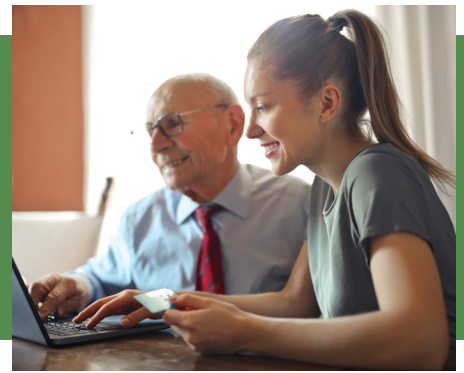


King County Nonprofit Wage & Benefits Survey



Take the guesswork out of determining competitive pay!

501 Commons and the King County Veterans, Seniors, and Human Services Levy (VSHSL) urge the nonprofit community to share their salary and benefits data through the [2025 Wage & Benefits Survey](#). The results will help remove the guesswork from setting compensation levels, enabling you to offer equitable pay that makes it easier for you to attract and retain talented employees.

The survey is open from February 3 to April 18, 2025.

The aggregated survey results will be published on 501 Commons' website and will include detailed data on current pay levels, benefits, and employment practices for the local nonprofit sector. All nonprofits based in or serving King County are encouraged to complete the survey so that the FREE accessible data can be as helpful, representative, and accurate as possible. The 2023 King County Nonprofit Wage & Benefits Survey Report featured salary information for 175 jobs. This year, we want to surpass that!
