

Cloudberry Backup

This winter, 501 Commons is rolling out stronger backup services for all Managed Services clients. This new service will replace current backup methods like CrashPlan, Veritas, or Windows Backup and will be deployed by your consultant team. We are excited about this new strategy because it provides greater adaptability for nonprofit settings, lower fees, and systematic backup schedules.

How is Cloudberry better for your organization?

Detailed Monitoring

Cloudberry allows for greater control in establishing backup settings. We can tailor rules to fit client data protocols or network constraints.

Automatic Offsite Backups

Precisely this – backups occurring systematically and stored offsite. It means reliable and safe disaster recovery.

Saves Money

Overall pricing is significantly cheaper than existing solutions. Monthly fees include \$5 per workstation (for client workstation file level backups) and \$15 for servers. This covers all licensing costs and is significantly less expensive than the other solutions we commonly see in non-profits. Storage (Azure) is provided through your Microsoft donation up to a \$3000 value.

501 Commons has also secured grant funding to cover all deployment costs. Moving to Cloudberry will be **free** for all clients.

Adaptable for Most Platform and Storage Options

Cloudberry gives users the option to choose their own storage service. This gives the user (you) full control over the data and allows us to take advantage of Microsoft Azure sponsorships.

Cloudberry is also compatible with Mac OS environments.
